

Dear NJSAMS Users,

This Release Content Letter (RCL) announces for the two new Initiatives of State Targeted Opioid Response Initiative (STORI) and State Hospital Access to Rehabilitation & Education (SHARE) in NJSAMS 3.5 release. The highlights of the release is Introducing mobile application for the Substance Abuse Treatment Directory and Enhancements between NJSAMS and CSC billing System for FFY 2018 cut over for State Fee For Services.

Core Features in NJSAMS 3.5

1. SHARE Initiative funding will be eligible for the consumer 18 years and older, New Jersey Resident and referral is made by Psychiatric Hospital for the short term level of care service.
2. STORI Initiative funding will be eligible for the consumer 18 years and older, federal poverty level FPL \leq 350%, New Jersey Resident and the consumer was/is participated in the Opioid Overdose Recovery Program (OORP) or use of other opiate.
3. FY 2018 Fiscal Cutover for State Fee For Services
4. "Hold for more Information" status in Extension Request LOCI (ERL) Review Module for IME like it is currently in regular clinical review.
5. CCBHC Program to capture in NJSAMS

Maintenance items include in NJSAMS 3.5

- IME requests
 1. In the ERL Excel export, change the columns as follows: Add "Reviewed By", "Discharge Date"; change "Evaluation Date" to "Review Date"; change "Admission Date" to "Sub. Date"
 2. In the ERL module, please add to the "Client Information" list: Client Name, Client SSN, Client Birthdate
- Client roster should show all licenses (including inactive licenses)
- Hospital users: System should allow to change password.
- Drop tables, columns within the tables and sp's those were not required
- **Not Found** : Alert message when a session expires
- Do not show non-managed ERLs to IME
- Client payer start date should be admission date not date entered while inserting first funding source.
- Agency name on every report.
- Recommended level of care is not populating OTP-OP in ERL
- **Automatic cancelling an authorization**: cancel date should discharge date or authorization start date which ever comes later.

Note:

DOC: DOC initiative will be terminated from Fee for Service network hence no authorization request is allowed to go to CSC for an authorization. "**Treatment Authorization**" button should not be available for this initiative.

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
